
## VEHICLE PHOTO REPORT INSTRUCTIONS



## WHICH PHOTOGRAPHS MUST BE PRESENTED FOLLOWING CONCLUSION OF THE CASCO INSURANCE CONTRACT?



Mandatory: photograph of the entire vehicle, which shows the licence plate number and front – the left side.




Mandatory: photograph of the vehicle's VIN (if not available – the chassis number) showing the part of the vehicle that allows to identify the vehicle.



Mandatory: photograph of the entire vehicle, which shows the licence plate number and front – the right side.



Mandatory: photograph of the dashboard of the vehicle with a running engine, which clearly depicts the mileage information.



Mandatory: photograph of the entire vehicle, which shows the licence plate number and back – the right side.



The vehicle photographs must include all other parts, unfolded mirrors, sun roof (if available), windshield, back and side windows.



Mandatory: photograph of the entire vehicle, which shows the licence plate number and back – the left side.



If there are any damages, provide a photograph, which clearly depicts these vehicle damages.

Make photographs of the damages from different angles from a distance no higher than 1 m from the vehicle.

## PHOTOGRAPHS SPECIFICATIONS:

- Photographs must be made no earlier than 5 days before the date they are uploaded.
- The vehicle must be photographed outside in the daylight, if due to poor weather conditions it is not
  possible to take photographs in the day light, it is permitted to photograph the vehicle in well-lit
  premises.
- The vehicle must be clean (e.g., not covered with snow, liquids, etc.). All parts of the bodywork of the vehicle must be visible (e.g., bumpers, wings, headlights, sides, etc.).
- Must be of an original size, not cropped or compressed.
- · Do not edit / retouch the photographs.

Make sure to provide proper quality photographs with clearly visible vehicle make and licence plate number, where the vehicle is not covered by other objects and without sunlight glares and shadows, etc. If the photograph shows unrelated persons or objects, such as another vehicle

with a licence plate number, the data of the vehicle or natural person not related to the insurance contract must be blacked out before saving the photos or sending them to a company representative.
